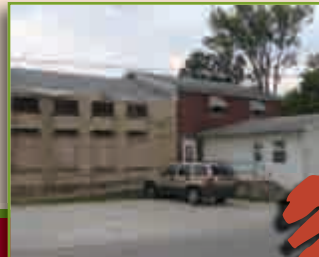
## Caring Heart's

The board, administrator and staff have long recognized the need for a facility that combines the services and staff of the organization.



Currently, we operate out of two separate locations, one of which used to be the county jail. There are issues with space to provide health education services for clients, and a lack of space for staff and records. Both existing facilities were constructed in the mid- to late-1800s and have been identified as having asbestos and lead paint. Because the nature of our services and the high traffic of children and older adults in the clinics, it is imperative that an environmentally safe facility be constructed.

The growing population of the county is placing an increasing burden on the organization relative to not only public health services, but also on the home care and hospice programs. As the population of the county continues to age, there will be an increasing need for home care and hospice services, with potential for an inpatient



hospice facility that allows for hospice care on-site 24 hours a day, seven days a week.

The Mission of Pike County Health Department, Home Care and Hospice is to promote safety, wellness and comfort for our community by providing quality care and preventive services so that all may experience a healthy, fulfilling and meaningful life.

### History

Pike County Health Department, Home Care and Hospice has a long history of providing preventive and health care services to Pike County residents. Public health services have been provided since the 1950's, with Medicare/Medicaid home health services added in 1969. In 1993, hospice was founded. Pike County is one of only six county-based hospices in the State of Missouri. In-home services were added in 1996 to make our home care services even more comprehensive.

### Who We Serve

Pike County Health Department, Home Care and Hospice serves everyone - birth to death - by providing preventive and primary care services.

### Core Programs and Services

The core programs and services offered through Pike County Health Department, Home Care and Hospice vary to meet the needs of Pike County residents. In summary, they include hospice care, home health services, public health nursing, community health education, maternal and child health services, environmental services, emergency response/planning and communicable disease education.

### Caring Heart . . .

- ♥ Provided 5,418 home health visits;
- ♥ 13,642 public health home visits;
- ♥ 1,791 in-home personal care hours;
- ♥ 2,692 in home homemaker care hours;
- ♥ 691 in-home respite hours;
- ♥ Serve an average of 12 hospice patients monthly;
- ♥ Issued 1,372 birth certificates;
- ♥ Issued 43 temporary Medicaid cards;
- ♥ Administered 156 meningitis shots; and
- ♥ 1,247 immunizations;
- ♥ 267 tuberculosis tests;
- ♥ Served 467 WIC clients per month (5,606 visits); and
- ♥ 23 individuals per month through prenatal case management.

These are only a few brief examples of the type and volume of services provided by Pike County Health Department, Home Care and Hospice to Pike County residents.
