Project Update

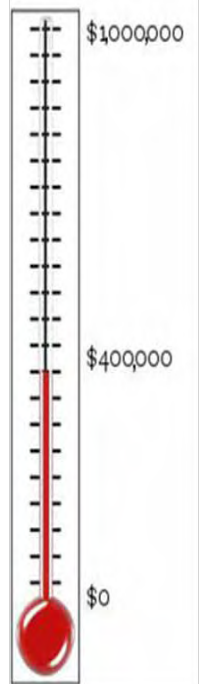
While ground has not been broken yet, the fundraising efforts have been very successful.
